FROM THE SOUTH on A9 (PERTH and towns along A9 such as Pitlochry).

We have ample parking outside the house on the street in a resident's only bay. On arrival we will give you a parking permit so your parking is free for the duration of your stay.

If you are driving from Glasgow or Edinburgh it is quickest to head towards Perth then 120 miles north up the A9.

Driving north from Perth when you approach Inverness you will come to a large roundabout near a big bridge going north over the Moray Firth.

Turn left here and follow signs for A82 Fort William and drive into Inverness on the dual carriageway called Longman Road.

Drive straight on at the next two roundabouts and when you approach a third roundabout (called Shore Street roundabout) get in the left hand lane.

Turn sharp left at the Shore Street roundabout and then get in the right hand lane once you pass a furniture store called Olgilvies. If you cross the river from this roundabout you have gone wrong. Head back over the river via roundabout on the other side.

At the first set of traffic lights turn right and drive down towards the river and round the corner. This is Bank Street, drive straight on at two more sets of lights passing the Mustard Seed Restaurant and keeping in the left hand lane coming up to the bridge.

You will see the castle above you on the left and a church straight ahead. At the church, turn right on to Ness Bank and we are the third house along with a big blue sign.
